



### Articulation Agreement

#### The King's University, Southlake, Texas and International House of Prayer University, Grandview, Missouri

The King's University, located in Southlake, Texas, and International House of Prayer University, located in Grandview, Missouri share a similar mission of preparing students to serve the whole Body of Christ under His Lordship in the advancement of God's Kingdom. Therefore, the two institutions hereby enter into the following articulation agreement, which shall continue until either or both institutions choose to terminate it.

#### **Goals of the articulation agreement:**

1. A collaboration between IHOPU and TKU that allows students from IHOPU to receive the maximum allowable credit toward an associate or baccalaureate degree at TKU.
2. Clear guidelines and degree plans that enable IHOPU students to plan effectively their transition from IHOPU to TKU and gain maximum allowable credit for their chosen degree.
3. Effective means of communication to raise awareness among IHOPU students as to the opportunities available at TKU through this articulation agreement.

#### **Provisions governing the agreement:**

1. IHOPU students must meet TKU minimum academic and admissions requirements in order to be considered for admission to TKU in compliance with the current academic catalog.
2. Representatives from TKU and IHOPU periodically will update the articulation agreement to ensure appropriate information is readily available to IHOPU students.
3. IHOPU agrees to annually provide TKU with a current academic catalog, course syllabi, and a full faculty roster indicating the academic credentials and qualifications of the faculty.
4. Transferability of credits for former IHOPU students will be assessed on a case-by-case basis in accordance with the established course equivalency guide.
5. Course equivalencies will be evaluated on an annual basis by the Registrar's Office and the Academic Office following review of current course descriptions requirements, and instructor qualifications.
6. Only courses with a final grade of "C-" or higher are eligible for transfer. Remedial or developmental courses do not qualify for transfer. All college transcripts must be submitted to the Registrar for evaluation prior to admission into TKU.
7. In order to receive a degree from TKU, students must successfully complete all graduation requirements listed in the current academic catalog.

#### **Special Provisions**

1. A limited number of four-year IHOPU graduates may apply to be considered for "special student status" which allows them to enter a graduate program at TKU directly after completing their studies at IHOPU. The following conditions must be satisfied for graduates to apply:
  - a. Minimal age of 25
  - b. Minimal GPA of 3.6
  - c. 4<sup>th</sup> Year Graduate
  - d. Staff/Faculty Reference
  - e. Academic Dean Reference
  - f. Student Leadership Experience (RA, Student Ministry Leader, Director's Team/Student Council)
