He was also a best-selling author, composer of praise and worship music, including *Majesty*, one of the most performed and influential musical pieces in recent history. He has accumulated a digitized inventoried library of over 25 years of platform ministry at The Church on the Way which is being preserved through Jack Hayford Ministries. He has graced the platforms of hundreds of churches speaking to hundreds of thousands of people while maintaining a personal ministry to countless individuals who have sought his insight and his teachings of Grace and Mercy.

In the midst of his ministry, On February 16, 1996, Dr. Jack Hayford was flying back to Los Angeles after speaking to more than 39,000 pastors at the Promise Keepers Clergy Conference held at the Georgia Dome in Atlanta—the largest gathering of pastors in modern day history. He was relaxing in his seat, looking out the plane window and enjoying the majestic beauty of the clouds floating at an altitude of 37,000 feet when, out of the blue, Pastor Jack heard a still, small Voice tell him to begin a seminary. What better way for Pastor Jack's legacy to continue than to begin to train the next generation of pastors and leaders from the seed of Pastor Jack's life of ministry. For 21 years The King's University has lived out this mission.

The definition of legacy is *something handed down by a predecessor*. It is our desire to ensure this legacy remains steadfast at the core of The King's University in perpetuity of this institution. It is also our desire to honor this man's legacy while he is still living. So that those he impacted can show their gratitude, and so that Pastor Jack Hayford might see the fruit of the countless seeds he has sown in the Kingdom of God.

- Endow the annual Jack Hayford lectureship (\$50,000)
- Fund the Jack Hayford Graduate Scholarship Fund (\$100,000)
- Fund the Jack Hayford Undergraduate Scholarship Fund (\$100,000)
