- Write the essay before starting your scholarship application.
- Answer all 4 (four) essay prompts in a single essay.
- The answers to each essay question must be 200-300 words in a paragraph style.
- The total word count of the essay must not exceed 1200 words.
- Include the student's name and your student ID number at the top of the essay.

Prompt 1:

Tell us how you came into a relationship with Jesus Christ.

Prompt 2:

Explain how you have exemplified a strong pursuit of excellence in your personal life, the body of Christ, and your relationships with peers.

Prompt 3:

Describe your motivation and call to full-time ministry, full-time mission field, or counseling.

Prompt 4:

Explain your call to The King's University and the impact you hope to have on the world.
